# Dear Parishioner,

I shall be in Glan Clwyd for the day on Tuesday for a minor adjustment to the surgery I had last year. One day and one night in hospital but, unfortunately, out of action for two weeks, and not able to drive either. As I shall be unable to say Mass for a while, I shall convalesce in Pwllheli. This will take up the first half of September.

For the second half of the month, I shall take my annual holiday.

I am arranging a supply for the first two weekends after my op, but for the last two weekends of the month, the weekends of my holiday, I shall come back for the Masses. Please don't expect a Newsletter!

On the weekdays of September, there will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 12 noon to half past the hour every day except on Wednesdays, when I hope to arrange a priest for Mass.

Sister Jennifer leaves today for her annual holiday and will be away for a fortnight. While both of us are away, please contact Mandy, my Secretary, if there is any kind of emergency. I will put her number on my answer-phone message. And while Sister is away, there will be no Holy Hour on the Wednesday evenings and no Children's Adoration on the Saturday mornings. A full timetable for September appears on the notice-board.

While trying to find a supply for the Masses for the first two weekends of September, I learned that Fr Brian Jones is poorly, and I ask you to remember him in your prayers. You will remember how good he was to us when I was ill last year; and I know how much you enjoyed his ministries.
