ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR: There has recently been some anti social behaviour within the Church grounds, which has been reported to the Police by some of our neighbours. Cllr. Mandy Hawkins has requested that we keep a watchful eye on our Church & premises & report ALL ASB to the Police on Tel No. 101 (non-emergency) or online (North Wales Police reporting portal). Always get a reference no. from the Police when you report, this is so you know that incidents have been logged officially onto the system. Reporting builds the evidence required for more patrols, resources & for a PSPO.

PRESBYTERY & CHURCH ROOF: We have embarked on another phase of work on the Presbytery roof. It is being repaired and re-laid. We hope that following this phase, the Presbytery will be ok. Please continue to pray for generous donors to enable us to fix the Church & complete the repairs on the Stella Maris roof also. Towards the end of this summer, the Chair of our Maintenance Committee will give the parish an update on the work completed so far. He will also be available to answer any questions that may arise.
